It has been very exciting to see all the new energy and enthusiasm on our General Board this year. This will be a building and development year for this group as we pursue finalizing our Constitution and By-Laws. The addition of new Elders has helped bring new life to the Eldership. I believe the Elders are stronger than ever, especially in their commitment to lead and guide our congregation spiritually. You will be seeing the Elders at all of our events and worship services as they help pray for and direct our body of believers towards God's truth and in walking according to His Word. Be praying for this group and their leadership.

Our new Sunday School class has seen wonderful attendance, and we have great facilitators who are helping to carry along the conversation of studying God's Word in response to the show "The Chosen." This class is the perfect opportunity to try a Sunday School class out. It is designed and intended for people of all knowledge levels of the Bible. Feel free to come and check it out Sunday mornings at 9:30 a.m. on the east side of the Fellowship Hall.

As most of you know, we have started a church-wide prayer initiative. Our Long-Range Planning Committee has brought forth concerns about the financial stability of our church. We only have enough working capitol to keep the doors open for little more than two years. This is very concerning, but we are trusting in the Lord for what He is doing. What has come from this committee, thank you to Terri Ralston, is a desire to be bringing all our concerns to God and to seek His will in communal prayer together.

The Elders have decided to help take the lead in guiding the congregation into this prayer initiative for the future of our church. We are asking that everyone take this time of Lent to be intentional in prayer for our church... specifically, our finances, leadership, and direction. Each Sunday, we will have a time of corporate prayer where everyone is invited to pray together before the end of the service. We are seeking to be intentional about pursuing God's will for our body.

All of this will be happening as we prepare for and lead up to Palm Sunday, Holy Week, and Resurrection Sunday. This will be a time of great celebration for what God has done for us in Jesus Christ and for what God is doing for the body of Christ here at Westmont through the power of the Holy Spirit. We will celebrate the Gospel, God's Word, and the work of the Holy Spirit in each of us. You will not want to miss out on any of the festivities as we seek to honor God in all we do.

May we all be challenged to walk according to God's truth and according to the fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law." May our generosity continue to flow as we trust in God and obey His Word. May we walk by faith in Christ.

God is doing something here at Westmont; there is certainly a glow of the Holy Spirit at work in His people. As we proclaim the Gospel and value God for who God is, God will revive in us a passion, fire and hunger for Him, His Word, for conviction of sin which leads us to repentance, to walk in holiness according to the Spirit, to have the confidence and courage to declare Christ, and have a constant joyful worship.

So pray for this church and the leadership, including your staff, the new Board, and our Eldership. May God continue to bless us as we seek to do His will, to His glory, and for His purposes. It is not about us, but all about His praise, honor, and glory. Let's pray that as the broken sinner comes to our church, they receive life through the Gospel message as the Holy Spirit empowers them to repent of their sin and believe in Christ.

Easter's on it's Way!



Meeting for Members of Westmont


The members of Westmont will meet on Sunday, March 19, 2023 following worship in the sanctuary for a called Congregational Meeting.


